STZs in China: Booming before 2008

- China's policy of attracting FDIs
- Weak control from central government
- Tax competition of local governments
- > Tax avoidance activities:
 - Incentives shopping



STZs in China: Stalling since 2008

- > Centralizing tax incentive power, with a few of exceptions
- Competitiveness against the neighboring countries
- > A new trend: business clusters without special tax policy
 - Economic and technology development zones (219)
 - border economic cooperation zones (16)
 - free trade zones (11)



Exporting the STZs Concept to Other Countries

> Overseas Economic and Trade Cooperation Zones:

■ 77 zones in 36 jurisdictions in last 10 years

- various kinds of tax incentives
- Doubts on the effectiveness of these tax incentives
- Chinese government's support: not tax, but other outbound investment facilities
